HIGH TRANSMISSION AREA RESTRICTIONS

INDIVIDUALS

- Face coverings are required for public indoor settings, and outside when physical distancing of at least six feet (6') is not feasible. This includes both employees and patrons.
- Maintain six foot (6') spacing from anyone outside of your household.
- Do not attend any casual social gatherings of more than 10 individuals.

EVENTS

Event hosts must:

- Require each person attending a public event to wear a face mask. *
- Submit an Event Management Template and COVID-19 Plan.
- Enforce these requirements or jeopardize their permit in future years.
- * There are no medical exemptions to the mask requirement at special events in Grand County.

BUSINESSES

All businesses (including bars and restaurants) must:

- Conspicuously post signage that masks are required for entry.
- Ask employees and customers experiencing COVID-19 symptoms to stay home.
- Provide notice of physical distancing requirements.
- Require face masks on all employees and request all patrons to wear masks unless actively eating or drinking.

Bars or restaurants must:

• Require six feet (6') of physical distance between each party, including in waiting and seating areas.



Failure to comply with state and local health orders may result in criminal citation under the Utah Public Health Code.
