

Are you visiting Arches National Park between April 3 & October 3, 2022?

Reservations are required between 6 am and 5 pm.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When are reservations required?

Between **April 3, 2022 and October 3, 2022** reservations are required for your vehicle to enter Arches National Park every day **between 6 am and 5 pm**. Reservations will allow visitors to enter the park during a one-hour window. For example, a 7 am ticket will allow entry between 7:00 and 7:59 am. Once you are inside the park you can stay as long as you like. You can also exit and re-enter the park on the same day once your Timed Entry Ticket is validated.

How can I make a reservation?

Reservations are available through any of the following:

- Online at **Recreation.gov** (free account required)
- Using the **Recreation.gov mobile app** (iOS/Android)
- Call the Reservation Line at **877-444-6777**
- Call the Reservation Line (**TDD**) at **877-833-6777**

There are no same-day sales at the park or through park offices.

How far in advance can I make my reservation?

- **3 Months in Advance** - Reservations can be made **3 months in advance**:
 - **April** reservations (April 3-30) open **January 3**.
 - **May** reservations (May 1-31) open **February 1**.
 - **June** reservations (June 1-30) open **March 1**.
 - **July** reservations (July 1-31) open **April 1**.
 - **August** reservations (August 1-31) open **May 1**.
 - **September** reservations (September 1-30) open **June 1**.
 - **October** reservations (October 1-3) open **July 1**.
- **One Day Before Your Visit** - A limited number of tickets will be available for purchase one day prior to entry at 6 pm MDT through Recreation.gov. These are expected to sell out quickly and visitors are encouraged to plan ahead.

How much does it cost to get a reservation?

The non-refundable reservation fee is \$2 per day.

Do I need to pay an Entrance Fee in addition to the Reservation Fee?

Yes. Entrance fees still apply. (Park passes are accepted.) Entrance Fees can be paid at the entrance station.

What if I have a campground reservation or a Fiery Furnace permit?

Reservations will not be required for those with camping permits, backcountry permits, or Fiery Furnace permits. You must show your campground reservation or other permit for entry into the park. Entrance fees still apply.

Do bicycles require reservations?

No, but the appropriate park entrance fee must be paid at the entrance station.

Can't get a reservation?

- **VISIT THE PARK AFTER 5 PM** - Consider visiting the park after 5 pm. Reservations are not required at that time. Sunset is one of the most beautiful times to visit and photograph Arches National Park.
- **COMMERCIAL TOURS** - Take a commercial tour of Arches National Park. Many outfitters in Moab offer guided tours of the park.
- **SPEND SOME TIME EXPLORING DOWNTOWN MOAB** - Enjoy Moab's great selection of restaurants, shops, galleries and museums.
- **VISIT MOAB'S OTHER PARKS** - Visit some of the other parks in the Moab area, such as Dead Horse Point State Park and Canyonlands National Park.
- **HIKE ON BLM LAND** - Enjoy some hikes on the thousands of square miles of beautiful Bureau of Land Management (BLM) land surrounding Moab.

To enter the park **April 3–October 3, 2022**, follow these steps:



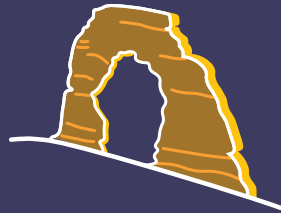
Secure your timed entry reservation
